Support	Expected impact	Cost
<b>Support Year 1 with individual reading support.</b>	Children are supported to catch up gaps created by the March lockdown. May crucial phonics sessions were missed, and one to one reading will support all children. Data in December and February will measure impact as will the June PSC.	£144 per month <b>(£1728)</b>
<b>Emotional support- an additional Place to Talk Session</b>	An additional Place To Talk session to support children's emotional wellbeing therefore allowing them to learn unencumbered by worries. Impact will be assessed based on Pupil Voice.  One to one counselling sessions with particularly vulnerable children requiring support to enable them to access learning.	£180 per month <b>(£1800)</b>  £60x19 <b>(£1140)</b>
<b>Reception support</b>	Part of a TA's time is allocated to catch up and support with Reception children. Impact measured by GLD.	£100 per month <b>(£1000)</b>
<b>Year 5 and 6 TA catch up support every afternoon</b>	An additional Teaching Assistant is working one to one with Years 5 and 6 to support catch up with the National Curriculum. Impact based on outcomes of SATs.	£601 per month <b>(£7212)</b>
<b>See and program</b>	Literacy based program to be used for catch-up for SEN children in Early Years. End of year Target Tracker data will monitor impact.	<b>£600</b>
<b>Curriculum Support</b>	Education City software for use throughout the school, literacy and numeracy catch up	<b>£780</b>
<b>Transition programme Year 6</b>	Extra year 6 transition programme for year 6 to ensure they are ready for high school.	<b>£800</b>
<b>CGP books</b>	Books for all classes purchased to support with catch-up both in school and when classes are in isolation. Impact measured by end of year Target Tracker data.	<b>£700</b> -rest subsidised by parental VC.
